



The Drappier family has been producing Champagne since **1808**. This historic and pioneering house was instrumental in reintroducing Pinot Noir to the Aube post phylloxera and it continues to work at the cutting edge of Champagne production. Provenance, excellence and distinctive style are the mantras, both in the vineyard, which are increasingly farmed according to organic principles, and in the cellar, where minimal use of sulphur is the rule and the wines remain unfiltered. In **2016**, Drappier became the first 'carbon neutral' Champagne house.

Champagne

- 1 **Champagne Drappier 1er Cru NV Brut** **125ml** £13.50 **Bottle** £78.00

60% Pinot Noir, 30% Chardonnay, 10% Pinot Meunier

The grapes come only from Grand Cru and Premier Cru vineyards. Very low in sulphur. Elegant and fresh on the nose. Firm and intense, with pear, spices, vanilla and a hint of acacia honey. Toasty bread, long on the palate with a light hazelnut aftertaste.

- 2 **Champagne Drappier Brut Rosé NV** **125ml** £14.95 **Bottle** £85.00

100% Pinot Noir

A unique Champagne Rosé made using the saignée method and with very low sulphur. Well structured, with exemplary purity of red fruits. Warm and satiny, lightly spiced with balanced hints of stoned fruits thanks to a lovely freshness in the finish.

- 3 **Champagne Drappier Brut Nature Sans Soufre** **Bottle** £98.00

100% Pinot Noir

A thrilling Champagne of real depth and energy, this sugar-free, sulphur-free blanc de noirs offers a rich nose of apple, pear and hazelnut, followed by a bone-dry palate full of refined lemon and mineral flavour.

- 4 **Champagne Drappier Grande Sendrée 2010** **Bottle** £150.00

92% Pinot Noir, 8% Chardonnay

Impressively rich and savoury, Drappier's flagship wine shows complex, mature notes of dried fruit, toast and wax, alongside vivid stone fruit and citrus flavours. The palate is graceful despite its underlying power and finishes extremely long.

Sparkling Wine

- 5 **Prosecco Extra Dry Bella Reta, Veneto, Italy NV** **125ml** £6.95 **Bottle** £36.00

A classic prosecco with aromas of white peach, pear and flowers. The palate is fresh, not too dry, and clean as a whistle all the way through to the sparkling finish. Vegan.

- 6 **Crémant du Jura Domaine Grand 'Prestige', Jura, France, NV** **Bottle** £52.00

Domaine Grand Crémant du Jura is a part-barrel-fermented, traditional method 100% Chardonnay. Floral, creamy and refined, with crisp white fruits, white flowers and hints of nuts (almond) and mineral to the finish. Vegan.

- 7 **No. 1 Family Estate Rose, Marlborough, New Zealand, NV** **125ml** £11.75 **Bottle** £65.00

100% Pinot Noir. A delicate salmon-pink with a mass of tiny bubbles, the wine offers a seamless balance of subtle cherry and almond hints combined with a fresh acidity. Dry, yet fresh and elegant, this wine leaves a lasting impression of opulence and splendour.

Dry Whites - light, easy drinking

- 8 **Marsanne/Vermentino Joie de Vigne, Languedoc-Roussillon, France 2018** **£26.00**
Aromas of white fruits (peach, citrus, grapefruit) and a hint of peony lead to a crisp, fruity palate that is both easy to drink and refreshing.
- 9 **Grüner Veltliner, Gruber Röschitz, Weinveiertel, Austria 2020** **£39.00**
An exciting family winery, run by 3 siblings. Fruit is sourced from their 4 different vineyards with differing soil types. Bursting with tangy vibrant unoaked plump green fruits with hints of white pepper and peach. Organic & vegan
- 10 **Pinot Grigio 'Fireman's Line' Schiopetto, Friuli, Italy 2019** **£48.00**
Mario Schiopetto was regarded as the father of modern Italian white wine, his Friuli winery today making some of Italy's finest. This floral, juicy pinot grigio from younger vines around 20 years old is full of ripe pear, fennel, almond and mineral notes. Vegan
- 11 **Chablis, Hamelin, Burgundy, France 2018** **£52.00**
Soft rounded Chablis, smooth texture cut through with steely acidity. Crisp on the palate while displaying good depth of flavour, and a long, dynamic finish.
- 12 **Sancerre, Domaine La Barbotaine, Loire, France 2018** **£62.00**
Crisp, flavoursome Sancerre which offers elderflower and boxwood aromas. The palate shows juicy citrus fruit alongside the trademark elegance and minerality of the appellation. Vegan



Off Dry Whites - aromatic, riper fruit, dry

- 13 **Viognier, Revelation, Badet Clément, Languedoc-Roussillon, France 2018** **£34.00**
Bursting with typical flavours of apricot and peach alongside elegant floral notes. The palate is round, with a refreshing acidity and a perfectly balanced finish.
- 14 **Pinot Gris XIV, Pulenta Estate, Mendoza, Argentina 2019** **£38.00**
Fresh peaches, apricots and delicate white flowers dominate on the nose The palate is delicate and fruity with a fresh, balancing acidity and a long, elegant finish.
- 15 **Sauvignon Blanc, Blackenbrook, Nelson, New Zealand 2020** **£42.00**
Highly aromatic and focused, vibrantly fruity with pure passionfruit and gooseberry flavours supported by an interwoven thread of acidity. Vegan.
- 16 **Sauvignon/Sauvignon Gris/Sémillon, Château Montfollet Le Valentin, Bordeaux. France 2018** **£46.00**
Aromas of ripe grapefruit and pineapple leap out of the glass accented by hints of vanilla. Ripe and juicy, packed with vibrant fruit, this dry white has an appealing, almost creamy texture before finishing fresh and dry. Vegan.
- 17 **Riesling Kabinett Annaberg, Werner, Mosel, Germany 2018** **£49.00**
A classic Mosel Riesling with a fresh lemony fragrance and complex minerality and stone fruits on the palate as acidity and sweetness exist in perfect harmony.
- 18 **Dry Riesling, Head, Eden Valley, Barossa, Australia 2018** **£56.00**
A superb dry Riesling from some of the oldest vines in the region. Linear, tangy with crisp focused lime, orange blossom, developing notes of kerosene and added complexity. Vegan.
- 19 **Soave 'Colli Scaligeri' Sandro De Bruno, Veneto, Italy 2018** **£58.00**
A superb expression of the Garganega grape grown on volcanic soils using organic techniques. Golden in colour with concentrated nectarine almond and dried apricot. Powerful yet fresh.
- 20 **Chenin Blanc, Vouvray Sec Cuvee Amedee, Phillippe Brisebarre, Loire Valley, France 2006** **£63.00**
A white of great complexity with notes of ripe apple, a touch of quince and a delicate nutty finish. A medium-bodied dry white of great character and depth. Vegan.
- 21 **Montagny 1er Cru, Henri de Villamont, Burgundy, France 2014** **£70.00**
Richly vibrant white Burgundy, offering characteristic aromas of red apple and grilled nuts, and a creamy texture on the palate cut with some citrus freshness. Lovely balance and length complete this fine expression of the Henri de Villamont style.



Full-bodied Whites – powerful, full of flavour and concentration

- 22 **Chenin Blanc, Emprise, Anjou, Loire, France 2017** **£38.00**
Delicious, rich and unctuous. Shipped with some bottle age which really makes this Chenin Blanc shine. Slightly off-dry with baked apples, quince, apricot and hints of beeswax.
- 23 **Chardonnay Reserve, Org de Rac, Swartland, South Africa 2018** **£48.00**
Founded in 2001 as one of the first fully organic wineries in South Africa. Rich vanilla, toast and hazelnuts with apple pie flavours and stone fruits on the pallet. Organic & vegan.
- 24 **Côtes du Rhône Village Blanc, Inopia, Rhône, France 2017** **£65.00**
Rich, decadent, but not heavy, this delicious white blend combines the sun-drenched stone fruit of the Midi with a seam of zest and minerality that lend an appetising, refreshing balance.
- 25 **Godello, ‘San Salvador’, Abad, Bierzo, Spain 2017** 125ml  **£15.50** **£78.00**
A single-vineyard barrel aged Godello from 80-year-old vines, this classy white displays creamy Burgundian characteristics, with hints of yellow peach skin, minerals and toasted nut. Vegan.
- 26 **Puligny-Montrachet, Bernard Millot, Burgundy, France 2017** 125ml  **£21.50** **£115.00**
Powerful wine with mineral notes and a well-integrated acidity. The most mineral of the “villages” wine from the Côte de Beaune.
- 27 **Cervaro della Sala, Antinori, Umbria, Italy 2019** 125ml  **£23.50** **£120.00**
Intense, complex aroma with notes of white flowers and flint balanced by a hint of vanilla. Full-bodied and well-structured palate with notes of toast, citrus and minerals. Elegant and persistent in the mouth, this is a wine with a long life ahead of it.
- 28 **Meursault, Pierre Morey Burgundy, France 2011** **£125.00**
Pierre Morey’s naturally focused, mineral style really sings here, with bright aromas of lemon and green apple complementing the creamy, nutty characters that have developed with age.



Rosé Wine

- 29 **Rioja Rosé, Conde Valdemar, Spain 2019** **£30.00**
Clear, pale salmon colour, with delicate raspberry fruit and the elegant herbal finish of Garnacha, overlaid with floral notes from the Mazuelo.
- 30 **Côtes de Provence Rosé Carte Noire, Les Maitres Vignerons de St Tropez, Provence, France 2019** **£39.00**
Very refined dry rosé, with an attractive floral aroma, redcurrant fruit, and excellent length in the mouth.
- 31 **Cabernet Franc/Syrah, Sunset Rose, Chateau Ksara, Lebanon 2019** **£48.00**
Chateau Ksara is Lebanon's largest and oldest commercial winery, established by Jesuit monks in 1857. Their Sunset Rose is a crisp wine that works perfectly as an aperitif or with Mediterranean cuisine. Deeply coloured with gorgeous aromas of strawberries and spice, this is juicy and lively on the palate with summer berries and cream. A fab rose!

Orange Wine

- 32 **Kisi, Dugladze, Kakheti, Georgia 2017** **£65.00**
Georgia, lying on the crossroads of Europe and Asia is sometimes referred to as "The Cradle of Wine" due to its 8000-year-old winemaking history. Many of the ancient techniques are still in use today.
- Historically wines were fermented with skins, stems and all in giant clay jars called Qvevri, often buried in soil, where they remained for several months or even years in extreme cases. This lends the white wines a unique textural element; amber-hued with the breadth and depth of a red wine including an appealing tannin component, while the process reduces the need for sulphur additions. These wines have proved the inspiration behind today's burgeoning orange wine movement.*
- The Kisi variety came close to extinction in 2000 yet has been revived as producers have recognised its potential to produce wines of great aroma, elegance, and refinement. When made in Qvevri the tannins seem more fully integrated and subtle than other varieties. This outstanding orange wine is from the Maghraani district, the birthplace of the Kisi variety. Fermented on skins and stems in Qvevri for 6 months following harvest with regular punching down to maximise extraction.*
- Perfumed with aromas of dried mango, honeydew melon and orange rind, this has a full bodied yet silky and elegant palate finishing dry with supple elegant tannins. A top-quality example of the genre.*



Light-bodied Reds – fruity, softer tannins

- 33 **Grenache/Pinot Noir, Joie de Vigne, Languedoc-Roussillon, France 2018** **£26.00**
Inviting aromas of red fruits are lifted by pepper and cinnamon. The palate is smooth and spicy, finishing on more berry fruit.
- 34 **Brouilly ‘Terre de Combatiey’ Manoir du Carra, Beaujolais, France 2019** **£38.00**
From 50-year-old Gamay vines grown on granite soils, this is a seductively perfumed light-medium bodied red with supple pomegranate, floral and red cherry fruits.
- 35 **Barbera/Nebbiolo, ‘The Truffle Hound’, Unico Zelo, Clare Valley, Australia 2019** **£56.00**
The wine pairs ripe fruit flavours with the crisp acidity that one would expect from these northern Italian varieties. Upfront blackberry and bitter cherry fruit give way to notes of dried herbs and anise. The finish is dry and persistent. Vegan
- 36 **Pinot Noir, Sancerre, Berthier, Loire, France 2018** **£62.00**
A family domaine now run by 2 young brothers Clément and Florian. This cool climate Pinot Noir from Burgundian clay-limestone soils, undergoes a warm fermentation for maximum colour and flavour extraction. Energetic, layered Pinot Noir showing pomegranate, raspberries with underlying earth and a peppery finish.
- 37 **Tinto Vulcânico, The Azores Wine Company, Açores, Portugal 2018** **£68.00**
The windswept archipelago of the Azores in the mid-Atlantic is one of the world’s most unique wine regions, recognised by Unesco. Vines have been planted here since the 15th century. A delicious blend of around a dozen local and international grape varieties, grown in unique, walled volcanic vineyards in the mid-Atlantic. Enticing and exotic on the nose with rosehip, rhubarb, raspberry and iodine. A definitive salty mineral character finishes on the vibrant palate. 1375 cases produced.
- 38 **Pinot Noir, Fess Parker, Santa Rita Hills, Santa Barbara, California, USA 2017** **£75.00**
An outstanding Pinot from the hills just inland from the Pacific Ocean. Full of raspberry liqueur, stewed plum, cinnamon and dark spices. Vegan.
- 39 **Pinot Noir, Father John Vine Hill Road, Russian River Valley, 125ml**  **£22.50** **£125.00**
California, USA 2017
A clear ruby red colour, this quietly magnificent Pinot Noir has a seductive, complex aroma of wild strawberry, redcurrant and fresh spice from whole bunches. The palate is medium-bodied, delicate, with great freshness and clarity of fruit expression.



Medium-bodied Reds

- 40 **Cabernet Sauvignon / Carmenere / Cabernet Franc, Reserva de Propiedad, Haras de Pirque, Maipo Valley, Chile 2017** £32.00
Minty, herbal notes, so typical of Maipo stand out on the nose whilst the palate is a riot of fresh red fruits and ripe cherries. Tannins are soft and supple giving the perfect counterpart to the juicy, fresh finish.
- 41 **Carignan/Grenache, Celler Masroig Rojalet Seleccio, Montsant, Spain 2018** £36.00
Medium-full with perfumed aromas of mulberry, blueberry and a hint of well-handled vanilla and coffee oak. Soft, supple and approachable, delivering delicious, lush early-drinking pleasure. Vegan.
- 42 **Syrah, Paritua 'Stone Paddock', Hawkes Bay, New Zealand 2019** £46.00
From rising star of the region Paritua (meaning the meandering stream above the ancient river). This Syrah shows ripe blueberry and violets with savoury notes of exotic spice and clove. The palate has flavours of plum, five spice and clove with white pepper and cedar on the finish. Vegan.
- 43 **Cabernet Sauvignon, Powers, Washington State, United States 2018** £50.00
97% Cabernet Sauvignon, blended with a tiny touch of Carménère and Merlot. Savoury notes of fennel and sage are backed by deep aromas of blackberry, black raspberry, and cassis, notes of wet limestone and gravel.
- 44 **Malbec I, Pulenta Estate, Mendoza, Argentina 2018** £53.00
The wine has a very bright and intense violet colour. Its aroma expresses red fruits like strawberries and cherries, balanced with the spicy notes of the oak. On the palate, it is round, with soft tannins and delicate mineral notes proving to be a wine of great character and remarkable structure.
- 45 **Chianti Classico, Pèppoli, Villa Antinori, Italy 2018** £56.00
Intense red fruit aromas are offset by delicate notes of vanilla and chocolate. Pleasantly lingering with a fresh, vibrant feel in the mouth.
- 46 **Crozes-Hermitage, Lauraent Habrard, Rhone, France 2018** £58.00
From an exciting dynamic thinking young winemaker. 100% organic Syrah fermented in concrete tanks and foot-trod daily using minimal sulphur during the winemaking process. Bottled unfiltered, to preserve texture and aromatics. Rich blackberry, black pepper and that textbook "animal" gamey character associated with good Crozes-Hermitage.
- 47 **Châteauneuf-du-Pape Domaine de Beurenard, Rhône Valley, France 2016** £68.00
An immensely fruity nose, with spicy and balsamic notes, then great complexity on the palate. Power, finesse, and an incredibly long, mineral-fresh finish.
- 48 **Chambolle-Musigny, Henri de Villamont, Burgundy, France 2015** £90.00
A delightful, graceful Chambolle that combines succulent blueberry and redcurrant fruit with the appellation's typical scent of jasmine and incense. Medium-bodied, with a fluid, silky texture, this is an elegant classic.



Full-bodied, heavier Reds

- 49 **Obidos Tinto, Casa Das Gaieras, Lisboa, Portugal 2019** **£32.00**
35% Touriga Nacional, 35% Tinta Roriz, 30% Syrah from coastal vineyards. Packed with powerful dark cherry fruits with hints of liquorice and pepper. Rich, juicy and structured with fine tannin and acidity.
- 50 **'Friends Red' Pedroncelli, Sonoma County, California, USA 2016** **£38.00**
73% Merlot, 12% Syrah, 8% Zinfandel, 7% Sangiovese. Cassis and plum on the nose, vanilla and mocha aromas developing. Velvety palate, with soft tannins and great balance.
- 51 **Shiraz, Woodstock 'Deep Sands', McLaren Vale, Australia 2015** **£40.00**
A superbly rich, multi-layered expression of Shiraz from its South Australian heartland. Full of dark sweet forest fruits with hints of Christmas spice and seaweed on a lingering palate.
- 52 **Tempranillo/Merlot/Cab Sauv, Ochoa Reverta, Navarra, Spain 2012** **£45.00**
All 3 varieties are harvested at different dates and vinified separately. Then aged in different types of oak to best suit the variety for 15 months. Ochoa then age the wine for a minimum of 5 years in bottle in their cellars so it is ready to drink upon release. Rich, earthy rounded and complex.
- 53 **Château Montaignillon, Montagne St Emilion, Bordeaux, France 2015** **£50.00**
An expressive nose of roasted plums, dried herbs and fresh earthy notes leads to a full, plush palate typical of this very successful vintage.
- 54 **Mencia 'Tessin de la Campana', Bodegas Abad, Spain 2014** **125ml**  **£14.95** **£72.00**
From a high-altitude single vineyard of 100-year-old vines. Handpicked and then hand sorted. Wonderfully perfumed with aromas of blackberry and mulberry touched with hints of cracked black pepper and exotic spices. Lovely refined long tannins roll out on the complex, beautifully balanced finish. Vegan.
- 55 **Rioja Reserva, Castillo de Mendoza, Rioja, Spain 2010** **£78.00**
A new star of Rioja. From a great vintage, this is a deep, rich red with layers of blackberry, violet, soy, liquorice and vanilla notes with a creamy texture, ripe, fine tannins and a finish that goes on forever.
- 56 **Barolo Serralunga, Paolo Manzone Piemonte, Italy 2015** **125ml**  **£15.95** **£85.00**
Perfumed notes of roses, maraschino cherry, damson and a touch of blackberry with gamey notes emerging with air. Ripe, fine tannins and poised with a balanced acidity.
- 57 **Château Batailley, Pauillac, Bordeaux, France 2012** **125ml**  **£21.50** **£115.00**
One of the oldest estates in Medoc, this is drinking superbly. A very typical Pauillac, showing firm cassis and cigar-box aromas, medium weight with a degree of power in the mouth, and a long savoury finish.
- 58 **Ermitage 'Les Dionnieres', Ferraton, Rhone, France 2012** **125ml**  **£26.50** **£145.00**
Since 1946, Ferraton Père & Fils has been settled in the heart of Tain l'Hermitage. Complex nose with aromas of violet flowers, small red berries, spices and liquorice. A full-bodied, long-lasting wine with great elegance. 94 points Wine Spectator.
- 59 **Tignanello, Villa Antinori Toscana IGT, Italy 2016** **125ml**  **£28.90** **£165.00**
An icon of Italian wines and the first ever 'Super Tuscan'. Predominately Sangiovese with Cabernet and Cabernet Franc making up the blend. Plum and cherries mingle with mint and liquorice, creating a vivid, harmonious balance from the first impression through to the long, savoury finish.

Dessert Wine

- 60 **Moscatel Naturalmente Dulce, Finca Antigua, Castilla-La Mancha, Spain 2018** Half Bottle: 375ml **£30.00**
Glass: 125ml **£10.50**
A stunning mixture of concentration and freshness, tingling with orangey acidity and floral, grapey aromas, then direct, powerful and surprisingly sweet on the palate. A tour de force!
- 61 **Muscat Noir, Woodstock, McClaren Vale, Australia NV** Half Bottle: 375ml **£30.00**
Glass: 125ml **£10.50**
A late-picked fortified wine that has aged in barrel for years before release, building sweet, nutty, raisined complexity along the way. Drink with blue cheese, chocolate or caramel desserts.
- 62 **Sauternes, Château Haut-Mayne, Bordeaux, France 2018** Half Bottle: 375ml **£35.00**
Glass: 125ml **£12.00**
The classic French dessert wine, a blend of late harvest botrytised Sauvignon and Semillon packed with ripe, honeyed tropical fruits overlaid with vanilla and hints of butterscotch.
- 63 **Tokaji Late Harvest 'Pallas', Fuleky, Tokaj, Hungary 2016** Bottle: 375ml **£45.00**
Glass: 125ml **£12.00**
A sweet, late-harvest blend of 50% Furmint, 40% Muskotály, 10% Hárslevelu. Floral notes of lychee and baked peach and an elegant refreshing sweetness that never overpowers.
